

New Cell Phone Laws

Effective July 1, 2008

Drivers 18 years of age or older are prohibited from driving a motor vehicle while using a wireless telephone unless a hands-free device is used (VC §23123).

Exceptions are making emergency services calls, operating a vehicle on private property, or using a "push-to-talk" two-way radio while operating a commercial vehicle (pickups excluded).

Minors (under 18 years of age) are prohibited from driving a motor vehicle while using a wireless telephone, including a hands-free device, and/or a mobile service device (pagers, texting devices, laptops, etc) (VC §23124).

Exceptions are making emergency services calls, operating a vehicle on private property.
